GENERAL BUSINESS

NEW BUSINESS

DUE PROCESS HEARINGS

The first item on the agenda was a due process hearing regarding Invisible Excavations, concerning the property located at 1633 Parkgate Road. Invisible Excavations was charged with violating the City of Columbus Building Code Section 4113.13, Work Without a Permit. The complaint was filed by the Hal Richard, Utilities Permit Manager, who was present. David Milko, the license holder was present and his attorney, Mark Shearer as well. After testimony by Hal Richard and Mr. Milko, questions and discussion by the Board and with the City Attorney's Office Representative, Westley Phillips, Hal Richard withdrew his complaint based on the fact that Mr. Milko did not work for Invisible Excavations at the beginning of the contract on this particular property. Chairman Baumann made a motion that the complaint be withdrawn at the request of Hal Richard, the complainant. Sam Mascari seconded the motion. **MOTION CARRIED** 7-0

The next item on the agenda was a due process hearing regarding TP Mechanical, concerning the property located at 96 South Grant Avenue. **TP Mechanincal** was charged with violating the City of Columbus Building Code Section 1133.10 - Notification for Inspection. The complaint was filed by Al Mackey, Construction Inspector, who was present. Doug Kraner, the license holder for TP Mechanical, was also present. After hearing testimony and evidence in this matter, the Board voted on a motion by Sam Mascari that TP Mechanical did work without notifying the Inspection Office. Dave O'Carroll seconded. 7-0

Due to the fact that TP Mechanical did this work, they were found guilty of violating Section 113.10, Notification for Inspection. Sam Mascari made the motion and Dave O'Carroll seconded.

MOTION CARRIED 7-0

As a result of being found guilty of violating Section 1133.10, Notification for Inspection Sam Mascari made a motion that TP Mechanical should prepare a Remedial Action Plan and return it to the Board by their next regularly scheduled meeting. Dave O'Carroll seconded.

MOTION CARRIED 7-0

The next item on the agenda was a due process hearing regarding Roto Rooter, concerning the several properties located in Columbus. Roto Rooter was charged with violating the 107.11, Protection and Restoration of Property. The complainant, Dennis Kuhlken, Construction Inspector I, was present. Terry Collins was present on behalf of Roto Rooter. After testimony and evidence was presented and discussion by the Board, it Sam Mascari made a motion that Roto Rooter get Al Mackey a list of all unfinished permits and complete them all before the next meeting. Dave O'Carroll seconded. **MOTION CARRIED 7-0**
