Implant

More than 99% effective
Lasts for 3 years
A tiny plastic rod placed under the skin of the upper arm by a health care professional



Non-Hormonal IUD

More than 99% effective
Lasts up to 10 years
A small T-shaped device made of plastic and copper placed into the uterus by a health care professional



Hormonal IUD

More than 99% effective
Lasts up to 3 or 5 years depending on type
A small T-shaped device made of plastic placed into the uterus by a health care professional
