Families that qualify can get a Pack 'n Play portable crib at no cost in order to provide a safe sleep space for their new baby. You will also get information about safe sleep practices. Please note that supplies are limited.

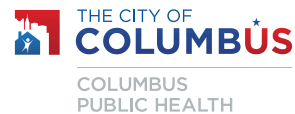
Are you Eligible?

To qualify, you must:

Be at least 32 weeks pregnant or have a baby less than 12 months old without a safe crib; and meet WIC income requirements (185 percent of Federal Poverty Income Guidelines).
