RULES AND REGULATIONS
Division of Water
Department of Public Service

Re: Water Lines on Private Property.

Effective immediately all water services either Domestic or Fire Protection will be metered at such a location that all outlets will be after the meter. The actual location of the meter shall be determined by the Division of Water and all meters over 1 1/2" shall be installed with a bypass so that the meter can be repaired without an interruption in service.

In the event a meter pit is required it shall be constructed in accordance with plans approved by the Division of Water, City of Columbus, Ohio.

This Rule and Regulation shall apply to all water consumers, connected to the City of Columbus, Ohio distribution system or any system operated and maintained by the City of Columbus as well as those areas where the City of Columbus reads and bills the individual accounts, where the installation is made after this date unless approval prior to this date has been given for an installation without a meter. Under no circumstances shall any service be installed after January 1, 1962, that does not meet the above requirements.
