

OFFICIAL NOTICE

RULE AND REGULATION NO. 95-01
SEWERAGE AND DRAINAGE DIVISION
BY ORDER OF THE DIRECTOR OF
PUBLIC UTILITIES

Pursuant to the Authority granted under Columbus City Codes Chapter 1145, the Director of the Department of Public Utilities hereby adopts, establishes, and publishes these rules and regulations to be effective at the earliest time allowed by law. These rules and regulations are in addition to any requirements presently established or as may be established from time to time by Ordinance or Resolution of the Department of Public Utilities or other offices, boards, commissions, agencies, divisions, or departments of the City.

Pursuant to Columbus City Code §1145.60, a fee of twenty-five dollars (\$25.00) is submitted with each Trucked Waste Discharge Permit Application for each vehicle for which a Permit is requested. A Trucked Waste Discharge Permit is valid for one (1) year from its date of issuance, unless suspended or revoked. However, several Trucked Waste Haulers operate more than one truck that hold different permit expiration dates for each vehicle. Pro-rated fees would be allowed for waste haulers that operate more than one truck in order to standardize the expiration date of all their trucks. The following pro-rated application fee schedule will allow a waste hauler who obtains a discharge permit for a new truck to secure the same permit expiration date as their other trucks.

QUARTERLY TRUCKED WASTE DISCHARGE PERMIT APPLICATION FEE SCHEDULE

First quarter (3 months)	\$ 6.25
Second quarter (6 months)	\$12.50
Third quarter (9 months)	\$18.75
Annual Fee (12 months)	\$25.00
