RE: VALVING ON TAPS LARGER THAN 2-INCH

July 14, 1969

Effective immediately all taps totally or partially under pavement shall have two valves. One valve at the main and the second valve outside the pavement on the applicant's side of the right-of-way. The tap shall be considered as that portion extending from the mainline through both valves. The tap shall be owned and maintained by the City of Columbus. All service lines after the second valve regardless of the amount within the right-of-way shall be owned and maintained by the property owner.

All taps where none of the tap is under pavement or traveled portion of the right-of-way shall be constructed using only one valve. The City of Columbus shall own and maintain that portion of the tap through the valve. All service line after the valve shall be owned and maintained by the property owner regardless of the amount of service line within the public right-of-way.

None of the above shall effect the requirements for taps 2-inch and smaller which require the use of a corporation stop and curb stop with box.
