TFC PLANNING DISCUSSION:

Focus of the meeting:

- TFC Sub-groups
- Meta-Themes
- Discussing objectives of each sub-group

The group discussed the possibility of narrowing the focus for the sub groups to **3 groups** instead of 5:

- Smoke-free housing
- Infant mortality
- Public places (which could include schools)

Meta themes that were decided upon by the group were:

- Prevention
- Education/resources
- Policy/enforcement

Structure of sub-group meetings:

When sub groups meet we thought it would be best if the groups focused on 1 or 2 meta themes to address and report out on. Goals and objectives can be identified through Healthy People 2020 and SHIP. Groups can choose 2 or 3 objectives and which meta theme they would like to focus on.

Example:

Sub Group – Smoke-free housing

Goal from Healthy People 2020 – Increase the proportion of smoke-free housing by 10% improvements.

Meta themes – Policy and education/resources

Things to consider:

- Quit line information is not clear as to what services are actually offered or available to people. How can we educate people on this resource?
- Infant mortality has 2 hot spots in Columbus – Franklinton, Linden, and South Side neighborhoods
- Should each group have a recorder to capture what is discussed and then report out on the appropriate meta themes?

Next meeting work:

Each sub-group should identify action steps around the meta themes for the sub-groups.
