Mr. Kaylor made a motion to certify the results of the applicants who were approved to the Department of Building & Zoning Services for the issuance of a Demolition Contractor's License. Mr. Wolt seconded the motion. **MOTION CARRIED.** 

The next item of business to come before the Board was a due process hearing regarding the City of Columbus vs. Brian Cady, HIC01656, for a property located at 7403 Palmleaf Lane. Mr. Cady was charged with violating Columbus Building Code Sections 4113.61, Plumbing Permits Required, 4115.01, Inspections Required, 4115.03, Approvals Required, 4115.04, Inspection Before Covering and 4114.111, Work of a Registered OCILB Licensed Specialty Contractor. He was present for the meeting. Ken Bruen, City of Columbus Structural Inspection Field Supervisor, stated on October 4, 2016, Plumbing Inspector Tim Rice was at this address performing an inspection on a hot water tank when he discovered the water was turned off. He further stated Mr. Rice found that Mr. Cady was doing a bathroom renovation installing a new tub without a permit. He stated on October, 5, 2016 the permit was pulled and a rough inspection was approved on October 7, 2016, however, as of today, no final inspection has been performed. Mr. Cady stated this was a Lowe's job and they just forgot to obtain the permit primarily because the invoice from Lowe's said "no permit required". Mr. Appeldorn made a motion to find that Mr. Cady did, in fact, begin work before having the necessary

permits. Mr. Neverman seconded the motion. **MOTION CARRIED**. Mr. Appeldorn made a motion to find that Mr. Cady did violate the abovementioned Code sections. Mr. Neverman seconded the motion. **MOTION CARRIED.** Mr. Appeldorn made a motion to take no action against Mr. Cady's license. Mr. Neverman seconded the motion. **MOTION CARRIED.** 

The next item of business to come before the Board was a due process hearing regarding Jennifer Small and the City of Columbus vs. Mike Turner, HIC01003, for a property located at 2880 Pamella Drive. Mr. Turner was charged with violating Columbus Building Code Sections 4113.61, Plumbing Permits Required, 4115.03, Approvals Required, and 4114.111, Work of a Registered OCILB Licensed Specialty Contractor. He was present for the meeting. Ken Bruen, City of Columbus Structural Inspection Field Supervisor, stated on March 28, 2016, Jennifer Small entered into a contract with Mr. Tuner for the construction of a bathroom addition. He further stated on September 29, 2016, Ms. Small filed a complaint against Mr. Turner because he had not completed the work. He stated he made a site visit on October 3, 2016 and found the addition was built, the electric was complete and the plumbing had been started but not completed and no Plumbing Permit existed. Mr. Turner stated the homeowner had changed several things from the original estimate and then on September 27, 2016, she called him and told him not to come back on the property. He also stated he thought it would be okay to run the drain pipe before pulling the Plumbing Permit. Mr. Appeldorn made a motion to find that Mr. Turner did, in fact, begin work before having the necessary permits. Mr. Neverman seconded the motion. MOTION CARRIED. Mr. Appeldorn made a motion to find that Mr. Turner did violate the abovementioned Code sections. Mr. Neverman seconded the motion. MOTION CARRIED. Mr. Appeldorn made a motion to suspend Mr. Turner's license for six months. Mr. Neverman seconded the motion. MOTION CARRIED.

Mr. Wolt moved to adjourn. Mr. Kaylor seconded the motion. **MOTION CARRIED.** Adjourned at 2:35 p.m.
