WHAT YOU NEED TO KNOW...

- If you see a live rat, call 614-645-3111.
- If you see a dead rat you can safely dispose of it using the following tips, or call 614-645-3111 for assistance.

Items needed...

- Covering for hands (*such as plastic bag, newspaper or disposable gloves*)
- Trash bag
- Shovel (*optional*)

What to do...

- Cover your hands
- Double bag the dead rat
- Tie bags up and place it and your hand covering into an approved dumpster or trash can
- **WASH YOUR HANDS!**
- If you find spilled or uncovered bait (*see picture*) you can safely dispose of it using the tips provided above for picking up dead rats or you may call 614-645-3111.
- If you believe a child has touched or eaten uncovered poison, call Poison Control at 1-800-222-1222.
- If you observe a bait station (*see picture*), **DO NOT TOUCH OR HANDLE.** If you have questions, call 614-645-3111.
- If you believe that a pet may have eaten uncovered poison, call your veterinarian or 614-645-3111.

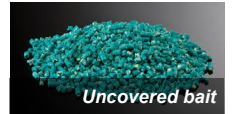
