High Street Streetscape Improvements, Vine Street to 9th Avenue



The departments of Development, Public Service and Public Utilities are collaborating to improve the streetscape on **High Street in the Short** North, Weinland Park and Greater Columbus Convention Center areas. The sections on High Street between Goodale Street and Convention Center Drive plus 7th to 9th avenues are scheduled to start construction in May 2017. The enhancements will improve safety, upgrade infrastructure above and below ground, provide accommodations for pedestrians and bicyclists, and include:

- → Sidewalks, curbs and curb ramps; resurfacing pavement as needed
- → Street lighting, traffic signals, signage, pedestrian countdown timers and push-button signals
- → Storm sewers and waterlines
- → Landscaping, trees and more

Representatives from the city of Columbus and designer Korda/Nemeth Engineering will be on-hand to give a presentation and answer questions on all phases of the project (see map on back side). Exhibits illustrating roadway features and property impacts will be on display.


