The next item to come before the Board was the review of new Demolition Contractor applications.

Mr. Wolt made a motion to certify the results of the applicants who were approved to the Department of Building & Zoning Services for the issuance of a Demolition Contractor's License. Mr. Sintic seconded the motion. **MOTION CARRIED.**

The next item to come before the Board was a due process hearing regarding Janice Lance and the City of Columbus vs. Michael Smith, HIC02076 – Lowe's, and Brian Cady, HIC01656 – Handyman Guys, for a property located at 2502 Timberside Drive. Mr. Smith and Mr. Cady were both charged with violating Columbus Building Code Section 4114.111, Work of a Registered OCILB Licensed Specialty Contractor. Ms. Lance, Mr. Smith and Mr. Cady were present for the meeting along with Alexander Andrews and Jake McKenna representing Lowe's and Jeff Berry representing Ms. Lance. Cliff Spruill, City of Columbus Structural Inspection Supervisor, stated Ms. Lance entered into a contract with Lowe's to do a kitchen remodel in March of 2016. He further stated Lowe's subcontracted the job to Brian Cady, Handyman Guys, and the work began in May of 2016, and at that time a building permit was obtained. He also stated a permit was pulled in Ms. Lance's name for the electric work. Ms. Lance stated she was not aware the electric permit was pulled in her name and she acknowledged that Handyman Guys did install 6 can lights and 4 under-the-cabinet lights under that permit. Mr. Spruill stated Mr. Cady is not a registered electrician in the City of Columbus. Mr. Andrews stated Lowes' contracts specify that either the subcontractor or the homeowner will pull all the appropriate permits. Mr. Smith stated Lowe's is no longer using Handyman Guys as a subcontractor. Mr. Cady stated Handyman Guys did install the can lights and under-the-cabinet lights at this address. Mr. Appeldorn made a motion to find that Mr. Smith did not perform the work of a licensed specialty contractor at this address. Mr. Wolt seconded the motion. MOTION CARRIED. Mr. Appeldorn made a motion to find that Mr. Smith was not in violation of the abovementioned Code Section. Mr. Wolt seconded the motion. MOTION CARRIED. Mr. Appeldorn made a motion to find that Mr. Cady did, in fact, perform the work of a licensed specialty contractor at this address. Mr. Wolt seconded the motion. MOTION CARRIED. Mr. Appeldorn made a motion to find Mr. Cady guilty of violating Columbus Building Code Section 4114.111. Mr. Wolt seconded the motion. MOTION CARRIED. Mr. Appeldorn made a motion to revoke Mr. Cady's license for a period of one year effective immediately. Mr. Wolt seconded the motion. MOTION CARRIED.

Mr. Neverman moved to adjourn. Mr. Appeldorn seconded the motion. **MOTION CARRIED.** Adjourned at 3:15 p.m.
