COMPLETE GENERAL CONSTRUCTION CREW COMES TO HIGH STREET MONDAY

There will be a few new faces to get to know starting Monday, May 15, as Complete General Construction crews begin their work to improve the streetscape along North High Street. Over the next few months, they'll be renewing the streetscape from just south of Vine Street to Goodale Street. Work will start next week in the area surrounding the Convention Center.

You'll see construction staff:

- Installing temporary traffic signals
- Removing trees and tree grates
- Installing temporary overhead utilities
- Installing water line and storm sewer in the roadway

During construction, expect:

- Pedestrian re-routing
- Front door access to all businesses maintained
- Sidewalks being removed along buildings in order to install soil and trees
- Lane closures, side-street re-routing and temporary parking changes
 - Side-street closures and other restrictions will be limited when possible to the hours of 9 a.m. to 4 p.m. weekdays and 7 a.m. to 7 p.m. on some weekends.

Please drive, walk and bike with extra care when in the work zone.
