

PROJECT UPDATE

CLOSURE AT EAST GOODALE

Construction has moved to the crosswalk at the intersection of East Goodale and High streets and is progressing on schedule. As with other crosswalk construction, vehicles cannot turn onto East Goodale.

Rerouting:

- The Goodale Garage remains open and accessible from I-670 in addition to the Convention Center doors east of the intersection. Foot traffic will be able to access the garage at street-level.
- Pedestrians will not be able to cross East Goodale between Black Point and the Greater Columbus Convention Center. Expect to route to the west side of the street near the Annunciation Greek Orthodox Cathedral and Hyde Park as an alternate.
- Vehicles should route via Nationwide Boulevard to the south.

NOISE IMPACTS

Noise impacts continue to stay at lower levels during intersection buildouts. Expects to encounter traditional safety/backup alarms, concrete trucks, and small- to moderate- sized construction equipment noises.

BETWEEN VINE AND GOODALE STREETS

- With the crosswalk at Spruce Street recently completed, brick paver sidewalks and bump-outs are now being installed over the next few days. The crosswalk at West Goodale Street is complete and sidewalks are now open to foot traffic.
- Valet services at the Cap at Union Station are being maintained and are fully functional, but have been repositioned. Please continue to follow signs and direction from staff when using valet services.
- Crews are now at the corner of High and Vine streets to work on the southwest corner of this intersection. They are installing new concrete sidewalk, brick pavers and a bump-out. Martini will remain accessible, with a longer route than normal to access its front door for the majority of foot traffic. Valet services for Martini will continue to function as it currently does.
