

PROJECT UPDATE

OCTOBER 10, 2017

EAST GOODALE RE-OPENS

Construction has progressed quickly and, with no delays encountered, the intersection of High Street and East Goodale has re-opened to vehicular traffic. Pedestrians should still expect to re-route to the west side of the street and cross to the Cap at Union Station on that side through the middle of the week until additional tasks on the sidewalks are completed.

NOISE IMPACTS

Noise impacts continue to stay at lower levels. Expect to experience traditional safety/backup alarms, concrete trucks, and small- to moderate- sized construction equipment noises.

BETWEEN VINE AND GOODALE STREETS

- At Spruce Street, installation of brick paver sidewalks and bump-outs is wrapping up.
- At the Cap at Union Station, crosswalk and sidewalk work is taking place on the east side of the street in front of Stack City and Black Point. Please continue to follow signs and direction from staff when using valet services at the Cap.
- Crews are now at the corner of High and Vine streets to work on the southwest corner of this intersection. They are installing new concrete sidewalk, brick pavers and a bump-out. Martini will remain accessible, with a longer route than normal to access its front door for the majority of foot traffic. Valet services for Martini will continue to function on Vine Street.
