Who: Anyone 15 & older with swimming ability to complete the American Red Cross Lifeguard class pre-test. The required Red Cross Lifeguard pre-test consists of:

- 1) 300 yards continuous swimming, freestyle and/or breaststroke.
- 2) Tread water for 2 minutes using only your legs.
- 3) Timed 10lb. brick retrieval in 8—10 feet of water (<100 seconds)

What: Lifeguard Training & Employment with City of Columbus, Recreation & Parks Dept.

When: Lifeguard training classes scheduled throughout Spring 2021!

March 7 through March 28 – Sunday Afternoons from 1:30pm to 7:30pm

April 11 through May 2 – Sunday Afternoons from 1:30pm to 7:30pm

April 5 through April 9 – Monday to Friday 11am to 5pm – CCS Spring Break

June 7 through June 11 – Monday to Friday 11am to 5pm

You must take the Lifeguard pre-test prior to the start of the class. Take the Lifeguard pre-test ANY day by appointment from now till May 15th. Call/email to schedule time & date of Pre-test. Pre-test early, space is limited.
