ADMISSION & REQUIREMENTS

Daily Admission: 50 cents per person

Annual Membership: \$25 for adults | \$20 for adults over 50 | \$70 for family of 4 (\$9 for each additional family member)

Visitors 6 years or older are required to have a leisure card, which can be purchased at the pool or recreation center. Leisure cards cost \$1 and expire 3 years after date of purchase.

All bags and coolers are subject to search upon entry.

GENERAL RULES

- Children under 8 must be accompanied by a responsible adult 18 years of age or older in a bathing suit. The adult must stay within an arm's reach of the child at all times.
- All observers must wear swimsuits. We do not permit street clothes in the pool area. Male swim trunks must have appropriate lining. We do not allow cut offs, basketball shorts, underwear, leotards or thongs.
- All children not potty trained must wear a swim diaper.
- All CRPD facilities are weapon (including CCW), smoking, drug and alcohol free zones.
- Please walk. No running due to risk of injury.
- CRPD is not responsible for stolen or lost items.

SIMPLE STEPS SAVE LIVES

Columbus Recreation and Parks encourages the use of U.S. Coast Guard approved flotation devices for all non-swimmers. We have puddle-jumpers and lifejackets available upon request. All non-swimmers and children under the age of 8 require close supervision in all aquatic environments with flotation devices.



SWIMMING LESSONS

Columbus Recreation and Parks Department offers FREE 30 minute swim lessons for anyone 3 years and older. Lessons are taught by certified American Red Cross Water Safety instructors. Register for Learn-to-Swim classes in person at requested pool site or at <http://bit.ly/CRPDSwimLessons>.

GENERAL WEATHER POLICY

- In the event of thunder or lightning, the pool will be cleared for a minimum of 30 minutes.
- Morning lessons will not be cancelled. In the event of storms, safety topics, and dry land activities will be conducted at the pool in lieu of class.
- Late afternoon or early evening thunderstorms may cause 6:30 p.m./6:45 p.m., swim lessons to be cancelled. No make up classes will be scheduled.
- Thunder or lightning after 6 p.m. (6:30 p.m., at Tuttle and Dodge) will result in the immediate closing of the pool.
