Advanced Tactics for Law Enforcement Women (ATLEW)

This is a three-day course in which law enforcement women will gain a better understanding of how to improve their safety and survival in encounters with combative and resistive subjects. This course emphasizes the tactics and techniques that work best given body size, shape, and relative strength. Students will refresh defensive tactics skills, and learn new skills including: subject control techniques, ground fighting, lethal force encounters. One entire day will be spent on the range where students will improve their skill level with their duty gun, shotgun, and patrol rifle (if applicable).

This Course is FREE. Students must be employed as a certified peace officer, police officer or constable, corrections officer, or other law enforcement position (OD&R Wildlife Officer, MetroParks officer, etc.) or hold a commission and serve as an auxiliary/reserve police officer or special deputy. The course hours are 8am-4pm each day. The reporting location for the first day of the course is the Columbus Division of Police Regional Training Center at 1000 N. Hague Ave., Columbus, OH 43204. Additional information will be provided to registered students approximately one week before the start of the course.

Students should dress comfortably with closed-toe athletic shoes or mat shoes for the first and last day of the course. Students will need their duty belt. Students are expected to participate in the defensive tactics and ground fighting exercises. Due to time restraints, students should pack their lunch if at all possible.

Students must bring duty ammunition, patrol rifle and ammunition, and shotgun if other than Remington 870. Total ammunition quantities will be sent to registered participants, but should not exceed 500 rounds of handgun ammunition, 100 rounds of .223 rifle ammunition, and 25 rounds of 12-gauge buck shot, and 5 12-gauge rifled slugs.
