<sup>\*</sup>If the candidate or ballot issue committee had cumulative contributions, debts, or expenditures less than \$1,000, a Notice of Exemption from Filing report must be filed in the Columbus Campaign Finance Database or the committee may choose to file a regular campaign finance report. However, the cumulative amount must be reported on the next Annual Report.

<sup>\*\*</sup>The 2022 Annual Report is not required if a committee was required to file a 2022 Post-General Election Report. A Form CCF-01 (Notice of Exemption from Filing) cannot be filed in lieu of an Annual Report even if the committee had no contributions or expenditures for the reporting period.

<sup>\*\*\*</sup>The Semiannual Report is required to be filed with the Franklin County Board of Elections only if the candidate did not file a Post-Primary Report and if the candidate had contributions exceeding \$10,000.
