Artist finalists Christian Moeller, Mark Reigelman and Marc Fornes presented their art proposals to the Art on High Art Panel. The Panel unanimously agreed to recommend Mark Reigelman to the Art Commission with the understanding that some changes could be made to the artwork that would maintain the artist's vision, while broadening the concept and form to include past, present and future maker items/culture in the City of Columbus. The Development Department wishes to secure CAC approval of the artist on 10/23 in order to submit legislation authorizing the Director to enter into contract with Reigelman and secure art funding.

SMART Columbus/CCAD Art Project

- The Advertising & Graphic Design department at CCAD is proposing to partner with Smart Columbus on a project to design public art installations for

electric vehicle charging infrastructure in Downtown Columbus, specifically at Gay & Front Streets and at Goodale Park. Rather than having large unattractive metal charging stations, this project will serve to beautify the neighborhood by converting the EV charging infrastructure into public art. At a minimum, students will propose designs for pavement marking / sidewalk art and some form of signing/display. Remaining and/or additional funds may be used for more variable items such as sculptures, awnings, space covers, building displays, lighting, etc
