Incident Summary: On January 8, 2019, at approximately 6:55 p.m., Columbus Police officers were called to the area of 1042 Lockbourne Road on the report of a shooting. Upon arrival, Officers found two individuals suffering from apparent gunshot wounds. C.F.D. Medic 815 arrived at the scene and transported one victim, later identified as Mark Tyshawn-Dominique Hardy, to Grant Medical Center with critical injuries that he ultimately would not survive and he was pronounced deceased at 7:34 p.m. The second victim, later identified as Charles William Allen Jr., was also transported to Grant Medical Center by C.F.D. Medic 15 where he remains in critical condition at this time.

Preliminary investigation revealed that both victims, along with other unknown individuals were together outside the above address when an altercation occurred resulting in the shooting. The initial cause of the altercation is unknown however it does appear that drugs may have been a precipitating factor. The investigation continues.

This is the 3rd Homicide in Columbus, Ohio in Calendar Year 2019. Incident #190021560. Detective Collins is the lead detective.
