Incident Summary:

On Monday, February 4, 2019 at approximately 7:25 PM, a pedestrian was crossing E. Whittier St, southbound, just east of S. Ohio Ave. At this same time, a silver colored 2016 to 2018 Chevrolet Malibu sedan was traveling westbound on E. Whittier St, heading toward S. Ohio Ave. The sedan struck the pedestrian and fled the scene, continuing westbound on Whittier, then northbound on Carpenter St. The pedestrian was transported to Grant Medical Center where he remains in life threatening condition.

The suspect vehicle will have fresh damage to the front bumper area, on the driver's side, as well as a damaged driver's door side mirror.
