Incident Summary: On 2/14/19, at about 9:00am, a teacher over heard the suspect ask another student if he could put his gun in his car. During the conversation, the suspect stated the gun was in his locker. The teacher notified the vice principal. The student uttered that the gun was not his but another student. When the detective talked to the arrested, he stated that he got the gun from the other student on his street. He stated that the other student asked him to keep it in his locker. The arrested stated that he put the gun in the locker and gave the other student his locker combination. When the other student did not pick up the gun, that was when he asked if he could keep the gun in the car.
