Types of Easements:

- (T) Temporary Construction Easement: right to use property belonging to another for a limited period of time for roadway construction purposes. This right is automatically extinguished at the completion of the project and may be extinguished sooner if all parties agree.
- (SL) Slope Easement) right to construct and to maintain a slope on property owned by another until
 such time as the owner desires to remove or build on the slope provided the removal or use of the slope
 will not adversely affect the highway.
- (S) Sewer Easement right to construct and to perpetually maintain a sewer outside of the right-of-way.
- (CH) Channel Easement right to construct and perpetually maintain an open watercourse outside of the right-of-way.
- (U) Utility Easement right to construct traffic control devices or underground conduit.
- (P) Permanent Easement right to construct a sidewalk or ADA ramps when fee simple title is not desired.
