Incident Summary: On Friday, July 19, 2019 at approximately 1:54 a.m., Columbus Police Officers were called to the area of 2677 Jonathan Parkway on the report of a shooting. Upon arrival, Officers found an unresponsive female, lying on the ground, suffering from an apparent gunshot wounds. CFD Medic 32 responded to the scene and transported the victim, later identified as Twyla Marie Dillard, to Mount Carmel East Hospital in critical condition. On August 9, 2019, Ms. Dillard succumbed to her injuries and was pronounced deceased by attending physicians at 12:25 p.m..

Investigation revealed that Ms. Dillard was attempting to break into a residence on Jonathan Parkway while actively violating a Civil Protection Order at the time of the shooting.

The investigation continues.
