On October 23, 2018, the Columbus Art Commission (CAC) approved the selection of Mark Reigelman II as the artist for the Art on High Public Art Project. Art on High is a component of the The Artist Selection Panel formed for this project unanimously selected Reigelman. In his proposal to the Panel, the artist shared his research for the art project and his attention to focus on the city's "maker history." Although they did not select a specific proposal, Panelists were excited by Reigelman's vision. They requested he continue to explore the maker theme in a contemporary overall shape or envelope, if possible incorporating modern maker items. The Panel declined to meet again, but asked to see the final art proposal.

Staff has shared early renditions of the proposal with Department of Public Service (DPS) representatives and provided feedback to the artist. A meeting with Reigelman and DPS staff has been scheduled during the artists visit to Columbus. Staff will report the outcomes of this and other meetings to the CAC at the hearing.

With receipt of Conceptual Approval, Reigelman will begin the Schematic Design and Development Phase. This will include development documents, including engineering, proposal details, placement, etc. Artist and Staff will work closely with DPS to secure their approval of the placement and engineering aspects of the proposal. Community input is also included in this phase.

Art on High is a component of the High Street Streetscape Project, a project of the Department of Public Service and the Development Department Public Art Program.
