Incident Summary: On October 11, 2019, at approximately 8:19 AM, officers were dispatched to 2864 E. 10th Avenue the report of a shooting. Upon arrival officers located Mr. Anthony Hill lying in the front yard suffering from several apparent gunshot wounds. Mr. Hill informed officers that as the result of an argument, he was shot and returned gunfire.

At approximately 8:35 AM, Mr. Fabien Mitchell checked himself in at a local area hospital with gunshot wounds to his right hand and torso. Mr. Mitchell gave an initial statement that was inconsistent with evidence. Mr. Mitchell was in stable condition. Mr. Hill was in serious but stable condition.

Witness statements indicate Mr. Mitchell may have been Mr. Hill's assailant. The incident remains under further investigation.
