**Incident Summary:** On June 15, 2020 at approximately 5:48p.m., Columbus Division of Police patrol officers responded to a report of a shooting at 988 North 9<sup>th</sup> Street. Prior to arrival officers were notified the victim had gone to an area hospital. Upon arrival at the hospital, officers met with Byran Bush, who was suffering from multiple gunshot wounds. Mr. Bush stated the shooting happened in the parking lot of 669 Gibbard Avenue, Mr. Bush stated there was an argument with Raymond Nickens. During the argument Mr. Nickens produced a handgun. Mr. Bush was trying to leave when Mr. Nickens fired multiple gunshots. The gunshots struck Mr. Bush. Mr. Bush was able to flee the area, and was taken to a Hospital for treatment. During the investigation, Mr. Nickens turned himself into Officers and Detectives at the scene without incident.
