Incident Summary: On June 17, 2020 at 6:04PM, a Columbus Police Sergeant was driving eastbound on Sullivant Ave. at Columbian Ave. when he heard a series of shots being fired and his cruiser was struck by a round. Witness told responding officers that they had observed several males run to a green Hyundai which then fled the scene. This car matched the description of a vehicle that had been recently used in several incidents in which shots had been fired. A short time later, the Hyundai was found in the area of W. Broad St. and Whitethorne Ave. with damage from several bullet strikes.

Plain clothes officers then surveilled several males who were behaving suspiciously near the Hyundai and watched as they hid several items in some bushes. Responding patrol officers then captured four of the males when they ran as the officers approached. Officers also recovered three handguns from the bushes where the males had been standing. Two of the males were juveniles and were arrested for outstanding warrants. Other two males, who were adults, were released at scene. This incident is still under investigation which will determine what, if any, charges will be filed.
