Incident Summary: On June 24th, 2020 at approximately 9:20 p.m. CPD Patrol Officers were dispatched to the intersection of E. Hudson Street and Medina Avenue on the report of a shooting. Upon arrival, officers located a gunshot victim who was identified as fourteen (14) year old Nyser Terry. Mr. Terry was transported to an area hospital where he was pronounced deceased at 9:45PM. During the investigation, detectives were able to establish that three (3) of the individuals, including the victim, while riding in a stolen vehicle, were firing gunshots from the vehicle at a group of people. Witnesses came forward identifying the listed suspects.

UPDATE

Mr. Davis was arrested out of a reported stolen vehicle on 6/26/2020. Homicide detectives were able to interview Mr. Davis where he confessed to the shooting leading to the arrest of both Mr. Davis and Mr. Hairston.

This was the City's 57th Homicide for 2020
