Art on High is the percent for art project created in conjunction with the city's High Street Streetscape Special Improvement Project encompassing the Short North and the Southern University District. The art is funded with a budget of 2% of the streetscape project or \$423,000.00. Reigelman was selected as the project artist following the creation of the Art on High Strategic Public Art Plan and Artist Call/RFQ The artist selection panel unanimously selected Reigelman for the public art project.

The project was conceptually approved by the CAC on 8.27.19. Following which, Reigelman entered into contract and began the Schematic Design and Development Phase. The materials presented include development documents, including project engineering and design details, schematics and placement information. Artist and Staff will work closely with the Department of Public Service on the placement and engineering aspects of the proposal. The proposal was submitted twice to the Victorian and Italian Village Commissions for comment. The artist responded to the site oriented comments with additions to the proposal document. The Board of the Short North Alliance is in support of the proposal. The project is currently undergoing the Department of Public Service Right of Way Review. (Schematics for ROW review have been included with the Commissioner materials.) The project proposal has also undergone conservation review by Tom Podnar, McKay lodge Laboratory Fine Art Conservation.

Action Requested:

Motion for final approval of the design and placement of the original artwork, *Columbus Crystals: The Makers Monument* at the northwest corner of West Hubbard and North High Street in the location shown in the submitted proposal and construction drawings, per Columbus Code Chapter 3115.04 (A) (C).

Other Business

Preliminary Project Discussion:

The Sullivant Bright Public Art and Parklet Project is a project supporting the Sullivant Avenue rehabilitation project from I-70 to Hague Avenue managed by the Department of Public Service. The project scope includes sidewalk and driveway repair, pavement maintenance, upgraded signals, lighting, and pedestrian crossing improvements inclusive of bumpouts and pedestrian refuge islands. Sites for public art and parklets will be integrated with the infrastructure improvements. The public art and parklet budget is \$200,000.00 with a target installation date of summer 2021.
