Incident Summary: On July 6, 2020, at approximately 3:38 p.m officers were dispatched to 1373 E 18th Ave, on a report of a shooting. Upon arrival to the location officers located Ms. Sunafrank lying on the floor of the livingroom suffering from a gunshot wound to the neck. Medics responded to the scene at which time Ms Sunafrank was transported to a local hospital in critical condition. Detectives talked to witnesses at the scene who stated that they were all in the location, when they heard a loud bang believed to be a gunshot. Witnesses state that after hearing the gunshot Ms. Sunafrank entered into the room and began yelling at which time they observed blood on the collar of her shirt. At this time it is believed to be an accidental shooting.
