**Incident Summary:** On July 11, 2020 at approximately 2:25 p.m., patrol officers were dispatched to the 2600 block of W. Broad St. on a shotspotter alert. At approximately 2:45 p.m., Nickeya Abshire walked into the Mount Carmel Franklinton ER with a gunshot wound to her right upper arm. Ms. Abshire stated that she was walking across the street near the intersection of N. Warren Ave. and W. Broad St. when she heard one (1) single gunshot and realized she was struck in her arm. Mr. Abshire was eventually transported to Nationwide Childrens Hospital in stable condition and treated for her wound.
