Incident Summary: On Monday, May 25, 2020, at approximately 12:58 PM, Columbus Police began receiving reports of 6 to 8 people fighting in the street at 1182 Smith Road. Additional callers reported hearing gunshots. Responding officers located the victim suffering from at least one gunshot wound. Columbus Fire Medics arrived and transported the victim to Grant Hospital in critical condition, where a physician later pronounced him deceased at 1:52 PM. Detectives filed a complaint charging the suspect, identified as 17-year-old Frank Demontae Turner, with Murder resulting in the issuance of an arrest warrant.
