Incident Summary: On 7/20/2020 at 9:48pm, Luke Huffines (28) of Columbus was operating a 2005 Yamaha motorcycle westbound on W. Mound St. approaching Souder Ave. At the same time an unknown driver in a 2015 Chrysler 200, dark blue in color, attempted to turn left from eastbound W. Mound St. to northbound Souder Ave. The Chrysler turned into the path of the Yamaha. The front of the Yamaha struck the right front/side of the Chrysler. The impact ejected Mr. Huffines from the Yamaha. The Chrysler stopped briefly before it fled the area. Mr. Huffines was transported to Grant Medical Center in critical condition. Mr. Huffines was treated for severe head injuries and is still in life threatening condition.				
The Accident Investigation Unit responded and initiated an investigation. Parts found at the crash scene belong to a 2015 Chrysler 200.
