### 2020 Fall Reservoir Litter Clean-ups Are Self-Guided!

Pick your date, pick your favorite reservoir location, and pick up litter!

September 19th through October 4th, 2020, volunteers are invited to pick up litter along the shorelines of Hoover, O'Shaughnessy and Griggs Reservoirs. City of Columbus Watershed Management will collect bagged litter and track the amount of participants and trash removed.

Trash bags are available for contact-free pick up, or volunteers can provide their own. Full bags collected from around the reservoir should be placed next to a green park trash can where they will be collected by city staff during routine weekly trash collections.
