Incident Summary: On the morning of May 30th, 2020 around midnight, multiple suspects broke into and stole property from JSK Carryout at 116 N. High St. Due to the rioting downtown Officers were unable to respond and secure the business so for the next 6 hours multiple suspects repeatedly looted this business. Over the coming weeks, we will be releasing multiple images of offenders who will be charged out of this incident. The first of these is an individual wearing a denim jacket with a distinct graphic and the word "ETERNAL" on the left shoulder. He can be seen stealing cigarettes and the store's cash register on security camera. Additional suspects are attached and anyone recognizing any person present is asked to let us know.
