Incident Summary: On 10/08/2020 around 8:10 P.M., a two unit motor vehicle crash occurred at the intersection of W. Broad St. and Interstate 70 on the west side of Columbus. A 2013 Chevrolet Impala, being operated by Raymond Stewart, 38 of Columbus, was traveling eastbound on W. Broad St at IR-70. A 2008 Hyundai Accent, being operated by Ashley Adams, 24 of Columbus, attempted to make a left turn from westbound W. Broad St. to eastbound Interstate 70 when the two vehicles collided.

Three juvenile occupants (2, 4, and 6) of the Hyundai Accent were transported to the Nationwide Children's Hospital. The 4 year old occupant was pronounced dead at the hospital. The 2 year old, and the 6 year old remain at the hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

Three additional juvenile occupants (4, 8, and 14) of the Chevrolet Impala were also transported to Nationwide Children's Hospital with non-life threatening injuries.

The cause of the crash remains under investigation. This is the 62nd reported motor vehicle crash fatality in the city limits of Columbus.
