Incident Summary: On November 3, 2020 at approximately 12:54 a.m. Officer J. Watson \#2873 observed a suspicious vehicle parked in front of 671 Ann St. Officer Watson approached the vehicle and began to investigate when he was approached by Rapheal V. Jones, the resident of 671 Ann St. Mr. Jones stated that a male had broken into his house and that he shot the male. Officer Watson loacted Branden M.

Longhenry laying in the back seat of the vehicle. Mr. Longhenry was suffering from a single gunshot wound to the torso. Mr. Longhenry was transported to Grant Hospital in critical condition. Mr. Longhenry is expected to survive his injuries.
