Incident Summary: On Friday 11/6/20 at 10:25pm Columbus Police responded to Riverside Hospital on the report of a walk-in shooting victim with a gunshot wound to the left ankle. Victim told Officers that the incident occurred at 2505 Brentnell Blvd., East Linden Elementary School. Officers went to the school and found some blood in the parking lot. Detectives interviewed the victim who stated her and her friends were having an argument with a girl on the phone and went to the school to fight. They fought and after the fight was over, shots rang out and the victim was struck in the ankle. Detectives went to the school and processed the scene by taking photographs.
