**Incident Summary: \*\*\*\*Update: 1-6-2021 - The Suspect in this Homicide has been identified as Ash Shaheed Abdullah Ibn Jamii. Two warrants for the arrest of the suspect have been filed for Murder. The Suspect's whereabouts are unknown at this time, and he is considered to be armed and dangerous.\*\*\*\***

On January 6, 2021, at 1:26am, Patrol Officers observed a suspicious vehicle parked in front of 1570 Fairwood Ave. Upon further investigation, Officers discovered two victims suffering from apparent gunshot wounds. Victim one, John Doe, was still seated in the vehicle, and he was pronounced at 1:35am by CFD Medic #14. Victim two, who was identified as Malik Amar, was located in the driveway in front of 1570 Fairwood Ave. Mr. Amar was also pronounced by CFD Medic #14 at 1:34am. The motive surrounding this incident is still under investigation. Detectives are currently attempting to locate person(s) of interest.
