Incident Summary:

On Tuesday, January 12, 2021, at 7:24PM, Columbus Police Officers were called to the E & E Market, located at 778 E. Hudson St., on a report of a shooting. On arrival, officers found Kiran Hill, 18, suffering from an apparent gunshot wound. CFD Medic 13 transported Hill to Riverside Methodist Hospital in critical condition, where he was pronounced deceased by attending physicians at 7:48PM.

The investigation revealed that Josiah Cocroft, 17, and Hill attempted to rob the unnamed victim. During the robbery Hill brandished a firearm. The unnamed victim, who is a CCW permit holder, produced his own handgun. Hill was then fatally wounded during an exchange of gunfire with the unnamed victim. Following the altercation, the unnamed victim remained at scene and waited for officers to arrive
