Incident Summary: On Thursday, January 14, 2021 at approximately 1:59 PM, Mr. Shane Gorslene (43) of Hilltonia Ave, was operating a Kia Amanti westbound on W. Mound St. east of Ryan Av. At this time, Mr. John Doe was operating a Toyota Avalon southbound on Ryan Av., north of W. Mound St. Mr. Doe's car entered W. Mound St. and into the path of Mr. Gorslene's car and the two collided.

Mr. Gorslene was evaluated at the scene with minor injuries. Mr. Doe was taken to Grant Medical Center by EMS with life-threatening injuries.

The Accident Investigation Unit responded and initiated an investigation, which is ongoing.
Mr. Doe died at Grant shortly before 7:00 PM.
To date in 2021, Columbus has had 7 fatal traffic crashes resulting in 7 fatalities.
Mr. Doe's identity will be released after next of kin has been located and notified.
