Incident Summary: On March 3, 2021 at approximately 12:27 p.m. officers were dispatced to the area of 1500 Polaris Pkwy. on report of a shooting. Upon arrival, officers located a scene inside and outside of the Carter's retail store. Officers as well as responding detectives conducted multiple interviews and reviewed multiple video sources that captured the incident. The footage reviewed shows an unknown black male individual fire multiple gunshots at another unknown black male individual inside the Carter's. The male who was being fired at then exits the store and fires multiple gunshots at the male walking away who just fired gunshots at him. There were no injuries reported in relation to this incident.  **UPDATE** The second suspect has been positively identified as Levon Lewis Sommerville. A warrant

A warrant for the arrest of Mr. Sommerville has been filed with the Delaware County Prosecutors Office for the charge of Felony Assault. The current whereabouts of Mr. Sommerville are unkown and active measures are being taken to locate and apprehend him. We are asking that Mr. Sommerville surrender himself peacefully to authorities to insure his safety and the safety of all parties involved. This case is still ongoing and information is being gathered in a effort to positively identify the remaining parties involved in this incident.
