Incident Summary: On March 20th, 2021 at 12:19a.m. Ivan Netter and Tushawn Hunt, who are both acquaintances, were at the Marathon Gas Station located 744 E. Hudson St. An argument ensued which devolved into a gunfight. Both combatants produced handguns and began firing at each other. Mr. Hunt received a gunshot wound to his back. He was able to drive away and was self-transported to OSU Hospital. Mr. Netter received a gunshot wound to the chest which pierced his lung which made him unable to breathe.

Officer Nathan Hargus #1550 responded to the call and found Mr. Netter bleeding profusely and unable to breathe. Officer Hargus rendered first aid to Mr. Netter which prevented him from suffocating. Mr. Netter is currently in critical condition at Riverside Hospital.
