**Incident Summary:** On June 4, 2021, at 3:51am, Patrol Officers were dispatched to 790 Canonby PI on a shooting. Upon arrival, they located victim #1, Mr. Emmanuel Lee Bryant, lying on the steps in front of 790 Canonby PI unresponsive and suffering from gunshot injuries. Mr. Bryant was transported to Grant Hospital by CFD Medic #3 in critical life threatening condition where he later succumbed to his injuries, and he was pronounced deceased at 4:30am. A short time later, patrol officers located victim #2, Ms. Keisha Williams F/B/39YOA, suffering from a gunshot wound to her leg. Ms. Williams was treated at scene and released by CFD Medic #10. At this time, Investigators are still attempting to determine a motive behind this shooting.
