Incident Summary: On Friday, July 2nd, 2021 at approximately 11:27 p.m., a female juvenile (16) was riding an electric-powered scooter near the intersection of E. Main Street & Carpenter Street. At this same time an unidentified vehicle was eastbound on E. Main Street approaching the same intersection. The unidentified vehicle then went left-of-center, accelerating to pass two other vehicles, and crossed into the westbound curb lane, striking the female juvenile. The juvenile suffered severe injury and was transported to Nationwide Children's Hospital where she remains in critical, life threatening condition. The suspect vehicle did not stop or attempt to render aid to the injured juvenile and fled the scene. The vehicle was last seen accelerating eastbound on E. Main Street, passing Champion Avenue and continuing eastbound.

****UPDATE**** After further investigation, the suspect vehicle involved in this incident is now believed to be a later-model Dodge Challenger or similar domestic sports car, grey in color with a black hardtop, loud exhaust and dark tinted windows. The lighter-colored black top vehicle depicted in the earlier informational summary has been determined to be uninvolved. ****UPDATE****
