Incident Summary: On July 20, 2021, at approximately 7:30 p.m., Columbus Police Patrol officers were dispatched to S. Souder Avenue and W. Mound Street on a report of a shooting. Upon the officer's arrival, they located the victim Josclyn Sellers suffering from a gunshot wound to her stomach. Ms. Sellers was transported to Grant Hospital in critical condition and immediately rushed into surgery. At the time of this release Ms. Sellers is in stable condition.

The shooting did not occur where the officers were called to and the exact location of the shooting is not known at this time. Ms. Sellers was inside of a black, 2012 Ford Fusion, bearing Ohio temporary license plate M504604 when the shooting occurred. The whereabouts of that vehicle are unknown and responding officers listed the vehicle as being stolen. If seen please call 911 immediately and report the location of the vehicle to the Columbus Division of Police.

The circumstances surrounding this shooting are still under investigation.
