Incident Summary: *UPDATE*** On July 19, 2021, the suspect from this case was arrested by a Columbus Police SWAT Unit. He is charged with the murder of George G. Valdez.**

*****UPDATE*** The victim out of this case has been identified as George Gregory Valdez, DOB 6/7/1999**

On June 12, 2021, at approximately 10:43pm, patrol officers were dispatched to the area of 668 Wedgewood Dr. on a report of gun shots. After a search of the area, a M/H victim was found unresponsive and suffering from gunshot injuries in front of 661 Kingsford Dr. The victim was transported by Franklin Township Medic 193 to Grant Hospital in critical life threatening condition where he later succumbed to his injuries and was pronounced deceased at 11:19pm.
