Incident Summary: On July 27, 2021 at approximately 9:00 p.m. officers were dispatched to the area of 66 S. Douglass Street on the report of a shooting. Upon arrival the officers determined there were multiple victims out of a shooting incident. One of the victims was treated at scene for a graze, another victim was transported to Grant hospital in critical condition. According to witnesses, this shooting was the end result of an ongoing dispute between neighbors that went from property damage, then to a fight with deadly weapons. During the dispute, there were two separate shooters, the first shooter was identified and charged while the second shooter was described as an unknown male black, who produced a handgun and shot into a car occupied by 4 people, striking one of the juvenile passengers leaving them in critical condition. At this time, she is expected to survive her injury. This incident is still under investigation. Anyone with information about this incident is asked to contact Det. D.
