- THE BLACK WALNUT TREE GROWS BEST IN YARDS WITH PLENTY OF SPACE. IN AN OPEN SPACE, IT CAN TOP 75 FT HIGH OR MORE!**
- THE FRUIT OF THE WALNUT (THE NUT) IS ENCASED IN A HARD SHELL THAT IS, IN TURN, ENCASED IN A YELLOW/GREEN HUSK.**
- INK AND DYE CAN BE MADE FROM SOAKING THE DRIED HUSKS. THE DYE IS A RICH BROWN AND CAN BE USED ON YARNS, FABRICS, AND EVEN HAIR.**
- THE BLACK WALNUT TREE CLEANS AND PROTECTS SOIL, ABSORBING AS MUCH AS 6,213 GALLONS OF STORMWATER RUNOFF EACH YEAR!**
